

**Seminole Community College  
Nursing Department  
Associate Degree Nursing to Practical Nursing  
Articulation Agreement**

It is the intent of this agreement, based upon section 464.008 (1) (C), F.S., that courses successfully completed in a professional nursing program as specified within, which are at least equivalent to a practical nursing program may be used to satisfy the educational requirements for licensure as a licensed practical nurse as outlined below.

**Provisions:**

1. Students who are no longer eligible to continue in the College's Associate in Science Degree Nursing Program and have been accepted into the College's Practical Nursing Program may participate in this agreement.
2. Students who transfer from another National League for Nursing accredited program in Florida and have pass/satisfactory/completed clinical evaluations from their former nursing program will also be considered eligible under the terms of this agreement.
3. This agreement takes effect 2005 and replaces any previous existing agreements. Students who have received credit under the previous agreements are not entitled to any rights or privileges granted under this agreement.
4. The above approved components are based upon the 2005 Seminole Community College Catalog and are subject to change by the BOR, DOE, and legislative action or by Seminole Community College without notice. This agreement shall continue until such time as Seminole Community College deems it necessary to revise or terminate the agreement.
5. Students who enter the Practical Nursing Program must take the TABE (Test of Adult Basic Education) test achieving a score of 11 in Math, Reading, and Language. Students must also complete a Medical Terminology course which is a prerequisite for entering the Practical Nursing Program.




