The Career Development Center (CDC) provides Seminole Community College (SCC) students and graduates with a wealth of information and support to assist them with exploring career options, making career decisions, researching transfer opportunities, and preparing to successfully transition into a cooperative education or professional employment position.

How does the Career Development Center assist students in their job search?

- Delivering employability skills seminars

- Managing the online job posting service

- Sponsoring career and job fairs

How do I register to use the Career Development Center's online job board, MySCCareer Source?

- You must be a current or past Seminole Community College student in order to use this service.
- If you qualify to register, begin by accessing the following Web site:
www.myinterfase.com/seminolecc/student
- Click on the "Click here to Register!" link.
- Complete all sections and click on the Register button. Required fields are marked with an asterisk (*).
- Click on the Submit Profile button.
- Once you have submitted your profile, your account will be in a pending status until approved by the system administrator.
- Congratulations! You are now a registered user of MySCCareer Source. You can now upload a resume or search for a job, internship or cooperative education opportunity.

What is a cooperative education/internship opportunity and how do I find out if I qualify?

Cooperative education is a unique plan of educational enrichment designed to make a student's educational program more relevant and meaningful by integrating formal academic study with practical work experience. Through a co-op experience, students earn academic credit while enhancing their classroom learning by working in positions directly related to their academic and career goals.
