Obtaining a Blood Sample DOT objective: 1 – 8.42

	Pass	Fail
Assembles and prepares all equipment		
Inspects blood tubes for expiration dates and /or damage		
Establishes IV access for obtaining blood from an IV (go to step 7)		
Applies constricting band and select appropriate site (non IV)		
Cleanses the site with alcohol or Betadine		
Inserts the end of the leur sampling needle into the vein and removes the constricting band		
Inserts the correct blood tube until the rubber covered needle punctures the rubber top/blood fills tube		
Gently agitates the tube to evenly mix the anticoagulant with the blood		
Places sterile gauze and tape or adhesive dressing		
Describes the proper blood tube labeling technique including Patient's name, age date and time drawn, and name of person drawing blood
