		Pass	Fail
1.	Assembles all equipment for drawing blood.		
2.	Uncaps the end of the central line device or pic line.		
3.	Cleanses the luman or port. ☠		
4.	Inserts needle from vacutainer.		
5.	Inserts blood tubes into the vacutainer and allows to fill each tube needed.		
6.	Monitors the patient's vital signs.		
7.	If the site is an important port only uses Huber needle instead of a regular needle to prevent damage to port.		
8.	Reassures the patient when the needle is passing through the skin of the implanted port.		
9.	Continues to monitor the patient's condition and vitals.
