Oral Medications DOT objective: 1 – 8.37 (1-8.33 BSI)

	Pass	Fail
Performs or verbalizes the appropriate BSI		
Note whether to administer medication with food or on an empty stomach		
Confirm the drug order, amount to be given and route		
Explains procedure to patient and rules out contraindications to medication/allergies		
Checks vital signs and places patient on ECG monitor		
Check the medication name, expiration, coloration and clarity		
Assembles the appropriate equipment		
Calculates the desired volume of the drug		
Has the patient sit upright (unless contraindicated)		
Places medication in the patient's mouth / self-administration preferred		
Follow with 4-8 oz of water, ensure patient has swallowed the medication		
Verbalizes the need to observe patient for desired effect/adverse side effect
