Parenteral Medication Administration DOT objective: 1 – 8.41 (1-8.33 BSI)

Performs or verbalizes the appropriate BSI		
Assesses patient to determine need for medication		
Assures patient's level of consciousness		
Confirm the drug order, amount to be given and route		
Explains procedure to patient and rules out contraindications to medication/allergies		
Checks vital signs and places patient on ECG monitor		
Check the medication name, expiration, coloration and clarity		
Assembles the appropriate equipment		
Calculates the desired volume of the drug		
Ejects air from syringe and preps the injection port		
Inserts the needle into the injection port and pinch the IV tubing		
Injects the desired amount of medication		
Verbalizes the need to observe patient for desired effect/adverse side effect		
Monitors the patient's ECG, vitals for medication effect.
