

## **Concurrent AS-BSN Enrollment Option**

### **Program Description:**

This program was designed by the UCF College of Nursing to create partnerships with area community colleges in order to help combat the nursing shortage in the Central Florida area. It offers an alternate nursing education opportunity for students who are not admitted in our limited enrollment program and an opportunity for qualified ASN students to earn their BSN sooner. This program allows integrated concurrent enrollment in both associate and baccalaureate nursing programs simultaneously. It is designed for academically talented students who desire a BSN in nursing.

The program allows qualified students to enroll in an associate degree nursing program while beginning courses in the UCF BSN program. Every semester students will take 8-10 credits of AS credit and 2-9 credits of UCF nursing course work. After five semesters, students graduate with the AAS in nursing, and are eligible to take the NCLEX exam and, once licensed, practice as an RN. After an additional one semester of full time study or two semesters of part time study, these students will complete the BSN in nursing.

### **Criteria for admission into the UCF/SCC Concurrent program:**

- are eligible for admission to UCF and to the UCF College of Nursing
- admitted to SCC's nursing program (Day or Evening)
- completed AA degree or met UCF's general education component
- completed Sociology (SYG 2000); Statistics (STA 2023); Chemistry (CHM 1032C)
- Completed two years of same foreign language from high school or college
- have an overall GPA of 2.8

### **Key points about the Concurrent Enrollment program:**

- This program is a partnership between UCF College of Nursing and Seminole Community College Department of Nursing to help combat the nursing shortage in the Central Florida area.
- This program allows qualified students who applied to the BSN program but were not admitted by the College of Nursing (due to lack of available class space) an opportunity to pursue a nursing degree at the local community college.
- This program also allows qualified Community College students who are admitted to the ASN program but also hold an AA degree or have met at least 18 credits of the UCF general education course requirements to begin early the RN to BSN program at UCF. These students must also meet all of the UCF nursing pre-requisites (including Chemistry, Statistics and Sociology).
- UCF classes during the first five semesters will be taught on the Altamonte Springs campus or via the web. Upon completion of the Associate Degree students are eligible to take RN-BSN courses at any UCF location including the fully web-based program.
