## STEPS FOR SUBMITTING AN SCC SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION:

1. Complete a Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) form and an SCC Application for Admission. Scholarship funds will be released only after the FAFSA has been received by the Financial Aid Department.
2. Type a 500-word essay describing your extra-curricular activities; educational and career goals; and financial situation. Include a current reference letter (no more than two) from an employer, teacher or community member and a copy of your most recent transcript (unofficial copies are accepted).
3. Submit the application to: SCC Admissions Department, Sanford/Lake Mary Campus, 100 Weldon Blvd. Sanford, FL 32773.  
Note: Incomplete applications will not be considered for review.

## SCHOLARSHIP INSTRUCTIONS:

Check the box that corresponds to the scholarship for which you would like to be considered. The Scholarship Committee will match all other scholarships you may be eligible for based on criteria and sufficient funds. Individuals submitting applications after the deadline will be considered only if there are remaining funds.

### FOUNDATION SCHOLARSHIPS

### ACADEMIC SCHOLARSHIP

Consideration for RECENT HIGH SCHOOL GRADUATES **ONLY**:

For priority consideration and acceptance, this application must be submitted by **March 9, 2009**. Individuals submitting applications after this deadline will be considered only if there are remaining funds. **Please consider me for one of the following scholarships.**

- Bright Future Companion Scholarship:  
This scholarship is available for high school graduates who are Bright Future recipients and will attend SCC in the fall term following their senior year. This companion scholarship covers \$300 each academic term and is renewable for an additional year, provided the student maintains the Bright Futures award. Summer funding is based on availability of funds. Completed scholarship applications need to be submitted to the Admissions Office by the priority deadline.
- Academic Scholarship:  
Scholarships are available for high school graduates who have a 3.0 GPA or above and are ineligible to receive the Florida Bright Future Scholarship. Recipients must attend SCC full-time in the fall term, following their senior year and maintain continuous full-time enrollment. The scholarship will cover tuition and/or fees up to maximum 12 credit hours per semester. It may be renewed for an additional year, provided the student maintains a 3.0 grade point average. Completed scholarship applications need to be submitted to the Admissions Office by the priority deadline.

### OTHER SCHOLARSHIPS

*Note: Academic scholarships are issued each term and are renewable for two consecutive terms only. Transfer students will be evaluated by their overall 3.0 GPA or by their SCC GPA of 3.0 after 12 credit hours have been completed.*

- Career Programs Scholarship:  
Pursuing an Associate in Science degree with a 3.0 SCC cumulative GPA. The award covers \$450 towards tuition/ fees. Recipients must be enrolled in at least 6 credit hours.
- Career Promise Scholarship:  
Pursuing an Associate in Science degree with a 2.75 SCC cumulative GPA. The award covers \$450 towards tuition and fees. Recipients must be enrolled in at least 6 credit hours. (Only issued one semester and is not renewable.)
- Achievement Award Scholarship:  
Pursuing an Associate in Arts degree with a 3.0 SCC cumulative GPA. The award covers \$300 towards tuition and fees. Recipients must be enrolled in at least 6 credit hours.
